Resolution in favor of the Chaplains of both Houses. Passed Mar. 10, 1834

*Resolved by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to the Reverend Mr. Blanchard, Chaplain of the Senate, and the Reverend Mr. Gere, Chaplain of the House of Delegates, or to their order respectively, the sum of one hundred dollars each, as compensation for their services during the present session.*

Resolution in favor of Silas Johnson. Passed Mar. 10,

*Resolved by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the treasurer of the Western Shore be and he is hereby authorised to pay to Silas Johnson, of Anne Arundel county, the amount of a fine that was imposed upon him at April term, eighteen hundred and thirty-two, which said fine has been paid by said Johnson and remitted by his excellency the Governor, with the advice of council.*
