CHAPTER 55.

*A supplement to an act, entitled, an act authorising a Lottery to raise a sum of money for the finishing of Washington academy, in Somerset county, and for other purposes, passed at November session, eighteen hundred and two, chapter eighty seven.* Passed Feb. 15, 1834

Section 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the Trustees of Washington Academy, shall be, and they are hereby declared entitled to the benefit of the original act to which this is a supplement. Right reserved

SEC. 2. AND WHEREAS, a new mode of drawing lotteries has been introduced, and it may be doubtful whether Washington Academy is authorised by the present acts of Assembly to cause their lottery to be drawn according to such new mode; *Be it enacted,* that the Trustees of Washington Academy, or any person or persons who have contracted for, or purchased, or may hereafter contract for, or purchase the right to the scheme of a lottery authorised to be drawn for their benefit, shall be at liberty to form, adopt, and draw a scheme of said lottery, in such mode and upon such principle as shall or may be approved by the Governor and Chancellor of the State of Maryland.
