Mr. Earle submitted the following amendments:

Strike out all after "A bill," and insert,

"Entitled an Act to appropriate a sum of money to pay the indebtedness of the Maryland Insane Asylum, and to provide for the proper leveling and drainage of the grounds immediately contiguous to the buildings.

Section. 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the President and Visitors of the Maryland Hospital, be and they are hereby required to execute such deeds or assignments of all their property and estate to the State of Maryland, as may be approved of by the Attorney General of this State, thereby renouncing all right to sell, lease or mortgage, or otherwise dispose of any of the aforesaid property, excepting as directed by the General Assembly of the State, to the satisfaction of the said Attorney General.
