Mr. Getty, from a Select Committee, reported favorably,

A bill entitled "An Act to authorize the County Commissioners of Garrett county to provide for and defray the expenses of taking the census of said county.

Which was read the first time.

Mr. Davis, from the Committee on the Library, reported favorably,

The House bill entitled "An Act authorizing and directing the State Librarian to furnish from the State Library for the use of the Circuit Court for Garrett county, a full set of the decisions of the Court of Appeals and of the Acts of Assembly and other books."

Which was read the second time.

Mr. Blake, from a Select Committee, reported favorably,

The House bill entitled "An Act to repeal and re-enact with amendments Section 811 of Article IV. of the Public Local Laws of the city of Baltimore entitled Police, and to repeal all Acts and parts of Acts inconsistent with the provisions of this Act.

Which was read the first time.

On motion by Mr. Brattan,

Leave was granted to Messrs. Brattan, Steiner and Tuck to report a bill providing for Local Option in Dames Quarter district in Somerset county.

Senate bill entitled "An Act to amend the Act of the General Assembly of 1872, chapter 196, entitled an Act to authorize the Comptroller of the Treasury to adjust and settle the accounts due by Collectors, Sheriffs, Clerks, Registers and other receivers of public moneys in cases where the indebtedness accrued prior to and including the year 1869, by repealing Section 1 of said Act and re-enacting the same with amendments,"

Was read the second time and ordered to be engrossed for a third reading.

Senate bill entitled "An Act to amend the Act of 1853, chapter 441, entitled an Act to continue the corporate existence of the several Banking Institutions therein mentioned, repealing the 5th and 9th sections thereof, and re-enacting the said 5th and 9th sections as amended,
