Presbyterian Church, to authorize them to have recorded certain amendments to the charter of said corporation.

On motion of Mr. Wack,

Leave was granted to the Allegany delegation to introduce a hawk and owl bill to apply to Allegany county.

On motion of Mr. Wier,

Leave was granted to the Allegany delegation to introduce a bill entitled an Act to authorize and empower the Agricultural and Mechanical Society of Allegany county and West Virginia and Pennsylvania, to issue coupon bonds, and secure the payment thereof by a deed of trust on all its property.

On motion of Mr. Bird,

Leave was granted to the Select Committee on Temperance to introduce a bill to provide against the evils resulting from the sale of intoxicating liquors in the State of Maryland.

On motion of Mr. Wack,

Leave was granted to the Allegany delegation to introduce a bill to authorize the County Commissioners of Allegany county to refund to W. Morgan an amount of money erroneously paid for license.

On motion of Mr. Groome,

Leave was granted to Messrs. Groome, Hines and Merritt, to report a bill to vest certain property therein mentioned in the Westminster Presbyterian Church, of Kent county.

On motion of Mr. Fowler,

Leave was granted to the Baltimore county delegation to introduce a bill to aid in the completion of Beach Field Avenue, in the first and thirteenth districts of Baltimore county.
