The undersigned, a minority of the Committee on the Judiciary, to whom was referred the bill entitled "An Act to provide for the defense of Officers of Registration, Judges of Election, and others, who are, or may be indicted in the United States Court, for acts done in the performance of duties imposed, or in the exercise of rights secured under the Constitution and Laws of this State, which acts are alleged to be in violation of the Act of Congress approved May 31st, 1870, &c." does not concur in the report of the majority of said Committee.
