

The bill was then read a second time and ordered to be engrossed for a third reading.

A bill entitled a Supplement to an Act passed by the General Assembly of Maryland at the January session, 1868, chapter 455, to confer certain powers upon a corporation therein named, to render effectual the said powers, by the correction of an error which occurred in said Act, and also to extend time for the payment of the capital stock of said Company, of the title, as corrected by this Act.

A bill entitled an Act to incorporate the town of Deer Park in Garrett county.

A bill entitled an Act to repeal an Act passed at the January session, 1872, chapter 320, entitled an Act for the better protection of Black Bass and other fish in the Monocacy River and its tributaries, within the limits of Frederick county.

Which was read a first time.

Mr. Groome, Chairman of a Select Committee, reported favorably,

A bill entitled an Act to authorize the Board of County Commissioners of Cecil County, to satisfy a judgment against the Trustees of the Elkton Academy in Cecil County,

Which was read a first time.

Mr. Gill, Chairman of a Select Committee, reported favorably,

A bill entitled an Act to extend the charter of incorporation of the Baltimore and Philadelphia Steamboat Company.
