

A bill entitled and Act to limit the hours of labor in this State for all minors under sixteen years of age.

Which was read a first time and referred to the Committee on Manufactures.

A bill entitled an Act to repeal an Act passed January session, 1870, chapter 441, so far as the same applies to Frederick county.

A bill entitled an Act to authorize the Mayor and Council of Hagerstown to borrow the sum of five thousand dollars to pay a judgment of Nathaniel Sehner, and a judgment of T. G. Gruber, recovered against them, to issue bonds for the payment of the same, and to levy taxes on the assessable property of Hagerstown to redeem said bonds and to pay the interest thereon.
