Also,

A bill entitled an Act to repeal section 1, of Article 73, of the Code of Public General Laws, entitled "Penitentiary," regulating the appointment of Directors of the Maryland Penitentiary, and to re-enact the same with amendments.

Which was read a first time and referred to the Committee on the Judiciary.

Mr. Watkins, Chairman of the Committee on Ways and Means, to whom was referred the Senate bill, entitled an Act to repeal section 105 and 106, of Article 26, of the Code of Public General Laws, title "Corporations," sub-title "Insurance Companies," and to re-enact the same with amendments,

Reported the same without amendment.

Said bill was then read a second time.
