The Secretary of the Senate delivered the following bills, Severally endorsed, "Passed by yeas and nays:"

A bill entitled an Act to incorporate the Frederick City Super-Phosphate Manufacturing Company.

Which was read a first time and referred to the Committee on Corporations.

Also,

A bill entitled an Act to refund to Isaiah Canter, the sum of four dollars and twenty-five cents, erroneously paid into the Treasury.

Which was read a first time and referred to the Committee on Claims.

Also,

A bill entitled an Act to refund to Nathan O. Neighbors, late Sheriff of Frederick county, the sum forty-nine dollars and forty-nine cents for money overpaid by him into the Treasury.

Which was read a first time and referred to the Committee on Claims.

Also,

A bill entitled an Act for the relief of the Bank of Commerce, cancelling three thousand eight hundred shares in the capital stock thereof, representing a portion of its assets, and reducing the par value of all other shares in its capital stock.

Which was read a first time and referred to the Committee on the Judiciary.

Returned the following House bill, endorsed, "Passed by yeas and nays,"

A bill entitled an Act authorizing and directing the State Librarian to furnish from the State Library, for the use of the Circuit Court of Garrett county, a full set of the decisions of the Court of Appeals and of the Acts of Assembly and other books.
