Leave was granted to the Frederick delegation to introduce a bill to prevent the carrying of weapons whilst attending places of divine worship, in Catoctin District, No. 6, in Frederick county.

On motion of Mr. Brace,

Leave was granted to Messrs. Brace, Frenner and West, to introduce a bill entitled an Act to repeal sections five and six of the Act of the General Assembly of Maryland, passed at January session, 1872, chapter 212, entitled an Act to provide for taking a vote for or against a new county in certain election districts in Allegany county, at the election to be held in the fall of 1872, and to re-enact the same with amendments.

Leave was granted to the Frederick delegation to introduce a bill entitled an Act to authorize the County Commissioners of Frederick county to subscribe to the capital stock and endorse the bonds of the Frederick and Pennsylvania Line Railroad Company.

Leave was granted to the Frederick delegation to introduce a bill entitled an Act to authorize and empower the Mayor, Aldermen and Common Council of Frederick, to subscribe to the capital stock of the Frederick and Pennsylvania Line Railroad Company, and to endorse the bonds of the said Company.

Leave was granted to the Committee on Extension of Baltimore City to introduce a bill to take in four square miles
