The bill entitled an Act to repeal sections 105, 106 and 107, of Article 3, of the Code of Public Local Laws, title "Baltimore County," sub-title "Fences," and sections 195, 196 and 197, of Article 3, of the Code of Public Local Laws, title "Baltimore County," sub-title "Trespass,"

Being upon a second reading,

On motion of Mr. Keech,

The further consideration thereof was postponed, and said bill recommitted to the Baltimore county delegation.

The bill entitled an Act to repeal all laws in Worcester county, entitled "Fencing," and re-enact the same with amendments,

Was read a third time and passed by yeas and nays, as follows:
