amended and re-enacted by chapter 340, of the Act passed January Session, 1872."

Which was read the first time and referred to Messrs. Walsh, Lloyd and Longwell.

The Senate bill entitled "An Act to regulate the sale and inspection of oils for illuminating purposes,"

Being on second reading,

On motion by Mr. Blake,

Was postponed until Thursday.

The Senate bill entitled "An Act to establish a Board of Public Charities,"

Being on second reading,

On motion by Mr. Stevens,

Further consideration thereof was postponed untill Thursday next.

On motion by Mr. Tuck,

Leave was granted to the Committee on Corporations, to report a bill to authorize the State Line and Juniata Rail Road Company of Pennsylvania, to extend its road and operate its line of Telegraph within the limits of this State.
