Said bill was then returned to the Senate.

The Senate bill entitled an Act relating to Building Associations, Homestead Associations and Land Companies, in this State,

Being upon a third reading,

The question recurring upon the amendment proposed by the Committee on Corporations, viz : 1st section, end of 17th line, add : *Provided*, the provisions of this Act do not apply to similar Associations in Montgomery, Allegany and Kent counties.

The amendment was then adopted.

On motion of Mr. Henkle,

The further consideration thereof was postponed, and said bill made the order of the day for Friday, the 13th instant.
