

The bill entitled an Act to add a new section to Article 5, of the Code of Public Local Laws, title "Calvert county," sub-title "Jurors,"

Was read a second time and ordered to be engrossed for a third reading.

The bill entitled an Act to repeal so much of the Act passed at the January session, 1870, chapter 434, entitled an Act to extend the jurisdiction of Justices of the Peace, in and for Dorchester, Kent, Caroline, Calvert, Carroll, Queen Anne's, Anne Arundel, Prince George's, Harford, Charles, and Worcester counties, to cases of assault and battery, and to extend the right of appeal so far only as the same relates to Kent county.
