A bill entitled an Act to repeal sections 1 and 2, of an Act of the General Assembly of Maryland, passed at January session, 1872, chapter 2, entitled an Act regulating fences in Wicomico county, and to re-enact the same with amendments.

Which was read a first time and referred to Messrs. Leonard, Bedsworth and Merritt.

Also,

A bill entitled an Act to prevent stock from running at large in Quantico, Wicomico county.

Which was read a first time and referred to Messrs Leonard. Bedsworth and Merritt.
