Leave was granted to the Committee on Corporations to introduce a bill to repeal an Act, chapter 260, of an Act passed 1870, to incorporate the town of Laurel, in Prince George's county.

On motion of Mr. McColgan,

Leave was granted to the Committee on the Judiciary to introduce a bill entitled an Act to add a sub-section to section 227, of Article 4, of the Code of Public Local Laws, entitled "City of Baltimore," sub-title "Elections," to be section 1 of said section 227 of said Article.
