AMENDMENT PROPOSED.

At the end of line 14, section 1, add: *Provided*, That nothing in this Act shall apply to non-resident defendants.

Which was adopted.

Mr. Keech submitted the following amendment:

AMENDMENT PROPOSED.

Add at end of section 14: *Provided*, That Baltimore, Talbot, Anne Arundel, Washington, Harford, Carroll, Frederick, Wicomico, Queen Anne's, Caroline and Dorchester counties, be excepted from the provisions of this Act.

Which was read.

Mr. Seth moved to lay the amendment on the table.

The question recurring upon concurring in the motion,

Mr. Stake demanded the yeas and nays.
