Which was read a first time.

Also, unfavorably,

An Act to prohibit the sale of spirituous or fermented liquors, or lager beer, within two miles of any camp-meeting grounds in this State, during the time meeting is held.

The report was adopted.

The Senate bill entitled an Act to refund to Morgan H. Clark, of Washington county, the sum of fifty dollars, paid by him into the Treasury on or about the 24th day of January, 1872.
