The Senate bill entitled an Act to amend the sixth section of the Act of 1858, chapter 410, entitled an Act to incorporate the Mineral Hill Mining Company of Maryland, by dispensing with the making and publication of the annual statement therein provided for, and by providing that statements of the affairs of the said Company shall be made as provided for in the sixty-sixth section of the Act of Assembly of 1868, chapter 471.

Which was read a second time.

The bill entitled an Act to pay and compensate Wm. Frank Tucker and Andrew K. Syester for legal services rendered in the United States Court, in defence of certain Officers of Registration, indicted and prosecuted therein, for an alleged violation of the Act of Congress, entitled "An Act to enforce the rights of citizens of the United States to vote in the several States of the Union, and other purposes,"

Was read a second time and ordered to be engrossed for a third reading.

The bill entitled an Act to authorize the Governor, Comptroller and Treasurer to settle the accounts of Charles E. Maguire, late Weigher of Live Stock, and to compromise with his sureties, if in their judgment the same is advisable,

Was read a third time and rejected by yeas and nays, as follows:
