Also,

The bill entitled an Act authorizing the appointment of an additional Justice of the Peace for Dorchester county.

Which was read a first time and referred to the Dorchester delegation.

Also,

The bill entitled an Act to repeal chapter 181, of the Acts of 1872, entitled an Act to repeal section 21, of Article 7, of the Code of Public, Local Laws, entitled "Carroll County," sub-title "Justices of the Peace and Constables," and to reenact the same with amendments, and to amend and re-enact the same.

Which was read a first time and referred to the Carroll delegation.

Also,

The bill entitled an Act supplementary to an Act entitled an Act to incorporate the Worcester Rail Road Company, passed at January session, 1853, with amendments enacted the 18th of March, 1867, and to repeal any part of said Act inconsistent with this Act.

Which was read a first time and referred to Messrs. Pruitt, Merrill and Leonard.

Also,

The bill entitled an Act to repeal and re-enact with amendments section 811, of Article 4, of the Public Local Laws of the City of Baltimore, entitled "Police," and to repeal all Acts and parts of Acts inconsistent with the provisions of this Act.

Which was read a first time and referred to the Select Committee on that subject.
