Leave was granted to the Anne Arundel delegation to introduce a bill to repeal an Act authorizing the County Commissioners of Anne Arundel county to subscribe to the capital stock of the Annapolis and North Severn Bridge Company, and to re-enact the same with amendments.

Leave was granted to the Committee on Elections to introduce a bill entitled an Act to repeal an Act passed January session, 1870, relating to the Registration of Voters, and to re-enact the same with amendments.

Leave was granted to the Committee on the Judiciary to introduce a bill entitled an Act to repeal section 20, of Article 28, of the Code of Public General Laws, title "County Commissioners," sub-title "Roads," and to re-enact the same with amendments.
