A bill entitled an Act to repeal chapter 287, of the Act passed January session, 1870, entitled an Act to repeal section 810, of Article 4, of the Code of Public Local Laws, chapter 367, passed at January session, 1867, and to re-enact the same with amendments.

A bill entitled an Act to extend the limits of Baltimore City, by including and annexing a part or portion of Baltimore county, in and to the said city, and to provide for taking a vote of the people residing in said part or portion to be so annexed, for or against such annexation.

Mr. Miller, Chairman of a Select Committee, reported favorably,

A bill entitled an Act to authorize the County Commissioners of Frederick county to build a new jail and a work-house for Frederick county, to borrow money on the credit of the county for that purpose, to issue bonds for the payment of the same, to levy and collect taxes for the payment of such bonds and the interest on the same.
