The bill entitled an Act to amend an Act entitled an Act to incorporate the Bachman Valley Rail Road Company, passed at January session, 1870, authorizing and empowering the President and Directors of said Company, or a majority of them, to issue the bonds of the said Company to an amount not exceeding fifty thousand dollars,
