No. 25. An Act to authorize the Trustees of the Almshouse for Allegany county to provide homes for children under their charge, by binding them out under indentures of apprenticeship.

No. 26. An Act to prohibit the granting of license for the sale of spirituous or fermented liquors or lager beer, at or near the ground of the Wesley Grove Camp-Meeting Association, in Howard county.
