

The Senate bill entitled an Act to repeal chapter 233, of the Acts of 1870, entitled an Act to repeal section 9, of Article 28, of the Code of Public General Laws, relating to the publication of county expenses, so far as the same relates to Caroline county, and to re-enact the same with amendments.
