Leave was granted to the Committee on Ways and Means to introduce a bill entitled an Act to repeal sections 1, 5 and 6, of an Act passed at the January session, 1872, chapter 36, entitled an Act to add a new Article to the Code of Public General Laws, regulating the inspection of tobacco, and to re-enact the same with amendments.

Leave was granted to the Kent delegation and Mr. Seth, to introduce a bill for the protection of partridges, and and to prevent trespassing with dog or gun in Kent county.
