The Senate bill entitled an Act authorizing the Baltimore, Chesapeake and Delaware Bay Rail Road Company to charge tolls on freights and passengers; to reduce the par value of the capital stock; to establish its principal office in Baltimore City; to lease, levy and build wharves, houses and shops; to charter, purchase and hold steamships, steamboats and barges; to provide for the condemnation of land and the construction of bridges and crossings; prescribing penalties for injuries done to said railroad or its property; authorizing the said Company to unite, connect and consolidate with the Baltimore, Chesapeake and Delaware Bay Rail Road, of the State of Delaware, and other railroads in or out of this State; to lease out their own, or to lease and operate other railroads; to issue mortgage bonds, and to provide for the payment of the same; to reduce the number of Directors; provide for the election of President and other officers of the Company, and to repeal all Acts inconsistent with this Act.
