A bill entitled an Act to repeal section 1, of Article 28, of the Code of Public General Laws, title "County Commissioners," and re-enact the same with amendments.

Which was read a first time.

Mr. Stake, Chairman of a Select Committee, reported favorably,

A bill entitled an Act to add an additional section to Article 21, of Public Local Laws, title "Washington County," sub-title "Roads."

Which was read a first time.

Mr. Lamar, Chairman of a Select Committee, reported favorably,

A bill entitled an Act to allow mileage to witnesses appearing before the Circuit Court for Frederick county.

Which was read a first time.

Also, unfavorably,

A bill entitled an Act to add an additional section to Article 30, of the Code of Public General Laws, relating to crimes and punishments, under the sub-head of "Religious Meetings."

The unfavorable report was adopted.

Mr. McColgan, Chairman of a Select Committee, reported favorably,

A bill entitled an Act supplementary to an Act passed at January session, 1870, chapter 168, entitled an additional supplement to an Act to incorporate the Roman Catholic Congregation in Baltimore Town, passed November session, 1795, chapter 15, to enable the said corporation to purchase a new burial-ground.

Which was read a first time.

Mr. Seth, Chairman of a Select Committee, reported favorably,

A bill entitled an Act to authorize citizens of Talbot and Dorchester counties to take or catch oysters with scoop or some in the waters of the Choptank River.

Which was read a first time.

Mr. Merryman, Chairman of a Select Committee, reported favorably,

A bill entitled an Act to improve the ground in front of the State House in Annapolis.
