hereafter to be granted by the County Commissioners, to make a record thereof, and to make a record of all the public roads heretofore opened by the County Commissioners, or used as public roads by the public,

Was read a second time and ordered to be engrossed for a third reading.

The bill entitled an Act to appropriate certain fines to purchasing a law library in the place of the one destroyed by fire, for the Circuit Court for Washington county,

Was read a second time and ordered to be engrossed for a third reading.

The bill entitled an Act to repeal section 206, of Article 20, of Public Local Laws, relating to Talbot county, subtitled "Wild Fowl," and to re-enact the same with amendments.

Was read a second time and ordered to be engrossed for a third reading.

The bill entitled an Act to approve an Act passed at January session, 1872, chapter two hundred and forty-five, entitled an Act to authorize the County Commissioners of Anne-Arundel county to subscribe to the capital stock of the Baltimore and Drum Point Rail Road Company, as provided by section fifty-four, of Article three, of the Constitution,

Was read a second time and ordered to be engrossed for a third reading.

The bill entitled an Act for the protection of partridges, and to prevent trespassing with dog or gun on private property,

Was read a second time and ordered to be engrossed for a third reading.

The bill entitled an Act to appropriate a sum of money to pay Daniel Grogg, of Carroll county, late Collector of State taxes, of Carroll county, for taxes overpaid into the State Treasury.

Was read a second time and ordered to be engrossed for a third reading.

The bill entitled an Act to add certain sub-sections to Article nineteen of the Code of Public General Laws, entitled "Somerset County" under sub-title "Licenses," and to repeal section one hundred and thirty-eight of said Article, entitled "Somerset County," under sub-title "Retailers,"

Was read a second time and ordered to be engressed for a third reading.
