Reported the same with proposed amendment.

AMENDMENT PROPOSED.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted*, That this Act shall not take effect until the Act authorizing the County Commissioners of Anne Arundel county to subscribe the sum of two hundred thousand dollars to the capital stock of said Baltimore and Drum Point Rail Road, passed at January session, 1872, chapter 254, be ratified finally and confirmed, and upon the going into effect of said Act for Anne Arundel county, this Act shall take effect and not before.

The amendment was adopted, and the bill, as amended, read a second time and ordered to be engrossed for a third reading.
