Leave was granted to the Committee on the Judiciary to repeal section 1, and section 4, of Article 13, of the Code of Public General Laws, title "Bastardy and Fornication," and re-enact the same with amendments.

On motion of Mr. Greenfield,

Leave was granted to the Committee on Internal Improvements to introduce a bill to incorporate the Maryland Canal Company.

On motion of Mr. Bond,

Leave was granted to Messrs. Bond, Colton and Hawkins to introduce a bill authorizing the Governor to appoint one additional Justice of the Peace for the second election district of St. Mary's county.
