Mr. Keech submitted the following amendments:

AMENDMENTS PROPOSED.

Add the following section, to come in after section 13, and be numbered section 14:

SECTION 14. *Be it enacted*, That the General Assembly of Maryland hereby reserves the right to alter, amend or repeal this Act at its pleasure.

Make section 14 read section 15.

The amendments proposed were severally read and adopted, and the bill, as amended, read a second time and ordered to be engrossed for a third reading.

Being upon a second reading,

Mr. Lamar submitted the following amendment:

AMENDMENT PROPOSED.

Sec. 1, line 6, after the word "attendance," add the following: "To be computed only one way."

The proposed amendment was adopted, and the bill, as amended, read a second time and ordered to be engrossed for a third reading.
