Also,

The Senate bill entitled an Act to repeal section 172, of Article 93, of the Code of Public General Laws, relating to Testamentary Law, and to re-enact the same with amendments.

Which was read a first time and referred to the Committee on the Judiciary.

Also,

The Senate bill entitled an Act to refund to Oliver P. Sparks, of Talbot county, a certain sum of money erroneously paid into the Treasury.

Which was read a first time and referred to the Committee on Claims.

Also,

The Senate bill entitled an Act authorizing the County Commissioners of Frederick county to allow a discount upon county tax.

Which was read a first time and referred to the Committee on the Judiciary.

Also,

The Senate bill entitled an Act to extend an Act to incorporate the Borden Mining Company, passed at December session, 1846, chapter 318, for the period of thirty years.

Which was read a first time and referred to the Committee on the Judiciary.

Also,

The Senate bill entitled an Act to authorize the County Commissioners of Cecil county to pay the Sheriff of said county a per diem for attendance in person or by deputy upon the Court, and such further compensation for other services as in their discretion may seem to them right and proper.

Which was read a first time and referred to the Cecil delegation.

Also,

The Senate bill entitled an Act to amend the charter of the Annapolis Savings Institution of Annapolis city, a corporation incorporated under the General Incorporation Act of 1868, chapter 471, and to add to the powers thereby conferred.

Which was read a first time and referred to the Committee on Corporations.
