Which was read a first time and referred to the Committee on the Judiciary.

The Senate bill entitled an Act to refund to John W. Tyler, Henry F. Chilton and Major Todd, the State's portion of certain fines remitted and certified by the Governor, after having been paid into the Treasury.

Which was read a first time and referred to the Committee on Claims.

Also,

The Senate bill entitled an Act for the support and treatment of indigent patients in the Baltimore Eye and Ear Institute of Baltimore City, and the Maryland Eye and Ear Institute.

Which was read a first time and referred to the Committee on Ways and Means.

The Senate bill entitled an Act to repeal section 12, of Article 25, of the Code of Public Local Laws of Harford county, sub-title "Almshouse," and re-enact the same with amendments.

The Senate bill entitled an Act to appropriate a sum of money to complete and ornament the Cemetery provided for the interment of the remains of the Confederate dead at Point Lookout.
