A bill entitled an Act to provide for additional compensation to Charles E. Hayward and Sewell T. Milborne, of Dorchester county, and to John W. Crisfield, of Somerset county, for professional services.

Which was read a first time and referred to the Committee on the Judicary.

Also,

A bill entitled an Act supplementary to an Act entitled an Act to incorporate the Maryland Institution for the Instruction of the Blind, passed May 19th, 1853.

Which was read a first time and referred to the Committee on Ways and Means.

Aso,

A bill entitled an Act to repeal section 62, of Article 75, title "Pleading, Practice and Process," sub-title "Practice," relating to interlocutory judgments and writs of inquiry, and to re-enact the same with amendments.

Which was read a first time and referred to the Committee on the Judiciary.

Also,

A bill entitled an Act to authorize the Clerk to the County Commissioners of Somerset county to administer oaths in certain cases.

Which was read a first time and referred to the Somerset delegation.

Also,

A bill entitled an Act to appropriate a sum of money to enable the Directors of the Maryland Institution for the Instruction of the Blind to pay off an indebtedness against that Institution.

Which was read a first time and referred to the Committee on Ways and Means.

Also,

A bill entitled an Act to amend an Act entitled an Act to incorporate the Methodist Episcopal Church in Frederick, passed February 24th, 1841, chapter 125.

Which was read a first time and referred to the Committee on Corporations.
