Which was read a first time and referred to the Committee on the Judiciary.

Also,

A bill entitled an Act to authorize the United States to procure the condemnation of lands within the State of Maryland, for certain public purposes, and ceding jurisdiction thereof, when so condemned, to the United States.

Which was read a first time and referred to the Committee on Federal Relations.

Also,

A bill entitled an Act to amend and enlarge the powers conferred upon the Roman Catholic Archbishop of Baltimore and his successors, by the Acts passed at December session, 1832, chapter 308, and by supplements thereto, passed at January session, 1868, chapter 268.

Which was read a first time and referred to the Committee on the Judiciary.

Also,

A bill entitled an Act to authorize the County Commissioners of Carroll county to levy for such sum of money as may be requisite to furnish the office of the Register of Wills of said county with the necessary record-books, stationery and fuel.

Which was read a first time and referred to the Carroll delegation.

Also,

A bill entitled an Act to declare the sanction of the General Assembly of Maryland to the bequest of John H. Yingling, late of the city of Westminster, deceased, to the Trustees of the Methodist Protestant Church of the city of Westminster, Carroll county, State of Maryland.

Which was read a first time and referred to the Committee on the Judiciary.

Also,

A bill entitled an Act to protect rabbits and partridges and a class of small birds known as insectiverous birds, in Baltimore county.

Which was read a first time and referred to the Baltimore county delegation.

Also,

A bill entitled an Act to appropriate a sum of money to pay Andrew Hamilton, and J. Weatherby & Sons, for labor done and material furnished the building used by the State Normal School.
