So the motion to substitute the bill for the unfavorable report of the Committee did not prevail.

The unfavorable report of the Committee was then adopted.

Mr. Watkins, Chairman of the Committee on Ways and Means, reported unfavorably upon,

A bill entitled an Act to repeal sections 1, 5 and 6, of an Act passed January session, 1872, chapter 36, entitled an Act to add a new Article to the Code of Public General Laws, regulating the inspection of tobacco, and re-enact the same with amendments.

And the unfavorable report was adopted.

Also, reported favorably upon,

A bill entitled an Act to improve the ground in front of the State House, Annapolis, with proposed amendment.

AMENDMENT PROPOSED.

Section 1, line 2, strike out the words "seven hundred and fifty," before the word "dollars," and insert "five hundred."
