The Senate bill entitled an Act to enlarge and extend the powers of the College of Physicians and Surgeons of the City of Baltimore.

The Senate bill entitled an Act to repeal and re-enact with amendments, section 3, of an Act passed at January session, 1870, chapter 304, entitled an Act to repeal section 1 and 2, of an Act passed at January session, 1868, chapter 266, entitled a supplement to the Act passed January session, 1864, chapter 116, entitled an Act to incorporate the Wicomico and Pocomoke Rail Road Company, with amendments, passed at December session, 1847, and to re-enact the same with amendments.
