

AMENDMENT PROPOSED.

Strike out all after the word "Act," in section 4, line 2, and insert the following in lieu thereof: "Shall on conviction thereof be adjudged guilty of a misdemeanor, and after presentment and indictment by a grand jury, and conviction, be fined not less than two dollars, or be imprisoned in the county jail not less than five nor more than ten days, at the discretion of the Court."
