A bill entitled an Act to provide for the payment of Lieutenants, Sergeants, Policemen and Turnkeys of the Baltimore City Police Force.

Which was read a first time.

Mr. Gordy, Chairman of a Select Committee, reported favorably,

A bill entitled an Act to prohibit trespassing with gun or dog upon private land in Dorchester county, and prescribing penalties therefor.

Which was read a first time and referred to the Committee on Agriculture.

Mr. Berry, Chairman of a Select Committee, reported favorably,

A bill entitled an Act to repeal sections 102 and 103, of Article 21, of the Public Local Laws, title "Washington County," sub-title "Fish," and to re-enact the same with amendments.

Which was read a first time.

Mr. Vanderford, Chairman of a Select Committee, reported favorably,

A bill entitled an Act to create an additional election district in Carroll county, to be styled the "13th Election District."

Which was read a first time.

Mr. Mackey, Chairman of a Select Committee, reported favorably,

A bill entitled an Act giving the sanction of the General Assembly of Maryland to the bequest in the last will and testament of Alice M. Gittings, late of Cecil county, deceased, to the Vestry of St. James' Church of Cecil county, Maryland.

Which was read a first time.

Mr. Merrill, Chairman of a Select Committee, reported favorably,

A bill entitled an Act to prevent the catching and destruction of fish in the waters of the Pocomoke River and Sound, below the village of Shell Town, in Somerset county.
