AMENDMENT PROPOSED.

Section 1, line 5, after the words "as follows," insert the following: "*Provided*, That such repeal shall not affect any appeals pending under the section hereby repealed, but the practice in any such pending appeal shall conform to the provisions of this Act."

The proposed amendment was adopted, and the bill, as amended, was read a second time and ordered to be engrossed for a third reading.
