

The Senate bill entitled an Act supplementary to an Act for founding an University in the City or Precincts of Baltimore, by the name of the "University of Maryland," and to authorize the Regents of the University of Maryland to dispose of a portion of the property held by the said University, for the use of its Faculty of Physic, and to apply the proceeds towards the erection of a Hospital for the use of the said Faculty and the School of Medicines under its direction,

Being upon its third reading,
