Preamble, line 17, strike out the word "town," and insert in lieu thereof, "city."

Which was adopted.

Mr. Greenfield submitted the following amendments:

AMENDMENTS PROPOSED.

Section 1, line 4, after the word "Negley," insert "G. H. Thurston, J. R. Moorhead, Frank Cowan." At the end of section, insert "in the same manner, and as to a large extent as if said rights, powers, exemptions, privileges, franchises had been particularly granted to the Cumberland and Ohio Canal Company by this Act."

The proposed amendments were severally read and adopted.

Mr. Greenfield submitted the following amendment:

AMENDMENT PROPOSED.

SEC. 8. *And be it enacted*, That the General Assembly hereby reserves to itself the right to alter, amend or repeal this Act at its pleasure.

Which was adopted.

The bill, as amended, was then read a second time, and ordered to be engrossed for a third reading.
