A bill entitled an Act to refund to I. Dyer, one of the firm of Penn, Dyer & Co., and of I. Dyer & Co., and of Thomas J. Hall & Co., and to Townsend, French & Co., monies erroneously paid as outage and storage on tobacco.

The unfavorable report was adopted.

On motion of Mr. Bond,

The vote by which the unfavorable report was adopted, was reconsidered.

When,

On motion of Mr. Bond,

The unfavorable report was non-concurred in, and the bill substituted therefor.

Said bill was then read a first time, and,

On motion of Mr. Bond,

Was referred to the Committee on the Judiciary.

Mr. Keech, from the Committee on the Judiciary, reported

The Senate bill entitled an Act to authorize the Johns Hopkins Hospital to purchase and hold tracts of land in Baltimore county, and to erect thereon buildings for the reception of convalescent patients from the said Hospital; and also to purchase and hold tracts of land in Baltimore county for the reception, education and care of orphan colored children, with proposed amendments.

#### AMENDMENTS PROPOSED.

Amend title of bill by striking out the words "in Baltimore county," in the fourth line of title thereof.

Amend the first section by striking out the words "in Baltimore county," in the 8th line of said section.

Amend the first section by inserting after the words "colored children," in the 12th and 13th lines, "not exceeding for both of the said particular purposes, three hundred acres of land."

The proposed amendments were severally read and adopted, and the bill, as amended, read a second time.
