Endorsed, "Reported unfavorably from the Committee on Corporations, and report adopted."

Mr. Freamer, Chairman of the Committee on Federal Relations, reported favorably,

A bill entitled an Act ceding to the United States of America the jurisdiction over the lands in Prince George's county, owned by the United States, and constituting the site of Fort Washington, and also over lands that may hereafter be conveyed to the United States, adjoining thereto, for military and naval purposes, and which are herein described.

Which was read a first time.

Mr. Foster, Chairman of the Committee on Claims, also reported favorably,

A bill entitled an Act to appropriate a sum of money to pay the claims of Daniel Caulk, Kelly, Piet & Company, Samuel W. Brooks, Kelly, Piet & Co., John Himelhaver, and Kelly, Piet & Company.

Which was read a first time.

Also, unfavorably,

A bill entitled an Act to refund to Jer. Dyer, one of the firm of Penn & Dyer, and of Jer. Dyer & Co., and to Thomas J. Hall & Co., and to Townsend, French & Co., monies erroneously paid as outage and storage on tobacco.

Which unfavorable report was adopted.

A bill entitled an Act regulating coal mines and the working thereof in Allegany and Garrett counties, in the State of Maryland.
