The bill entitled an Act to repeal an Act entitled an Act to repeal section 4, of Article 41, of the Code of Public General Laws, title "Fish and Fisheries," sub-title "Head of Bay," and to re-enact section 4, of Article 41, of the Code of Public General Laws.
