

Mr. Wier submitted the following order :

Mr. Latchford submitted the following order :

Ordered, That a suitable railing be placed around the graves of Wm. Price and Wm. Craig, deceased, late members of the General Assembly, who are buried in St. Ann's Cemetery in this city, and that a Committee of three be appointed for said purpose, the cost of said railing not to exceed one hundred dollars.

On motion of Mr. Koons,

Was laid on the table.

The Speaker presented the Third Annual Report of the Commissioners of Fisheries of the State of New Jersey.

Which was referred to the Select Committee to consider the Act authorizing the appointment of Commissioners to Examine the Fisheries of the State, chapter 297, 1870.

Mr. Koons submitted the following order :

Ordered, That the Committee on Claims be instructed to inquire and report to this House, within five days, the number of officers and attaches employed in and about the House, what their position and duties are, when they were appointed, and whether it is possible to comply with the order passed by this House to limit their pay to commence on the date of their appointment.

The following order :

Ordered, That the order passed by the House on the 18th of March, instant, in the following words, to wit: "Ordered, That the Sergeant-at-Arms of this House be allowed the same pay as is allowed to the Sergeant-at-Arms of the Senate," be and the same is hereby re-cinded.
