The following Acts of Assembly were this day presented to his Excellency the Governor for his approval, viz :

158. An Act to appropriate certain fines to purchasing a Law Library in place of the one destroyed by fire, for the Circuit Court for Washington county.

159. An Act to approve an Act passed January session, 1872, chapter 242, entitled an Act to authorize the County Commissioners of Calvert county to subscribe to the capital stock of the Baltimore and Drum Point Rail Road Company, as provided by section 54, Article 3, of the Constitution.

160. An Act to authorize the County Commissioners of Frederick county to build a new jail and a work house for Frederick county, to borrow money on the credit of the county for that purpose, to issue bonds for the payment of the same, to levy and collect taxes for the payment of such bonds and the interest on the same.

126. An Act to authorize the Town Commissioners of Berlin, in Worcester county, to erect a guard-house in said town.

161. An Act to amend an Act entitled an Act to incorporate the Bachman Valley Rail Road Company, passed at January session, 1870, authorizing and empowering the President and Directors of said Company, or a majority of them, to issue the bonds of the said Company to an amount not exceeding fifty thousand dollars.
