Line 15, section 9, after the word "be," insert the word "once."

After the word "published," same line, insert "in two newspapers published in Baltimore City, one of which shall be in the German language, and one in each county in English."

Mr. Keech submitted the following amendment:

AMENDMENT PROPOSED.

"But the Register shall not publish, or cause to be published, in any newspaper, any list of registered voters except the list of those transferred, dead, disqualified, removed, dropped from the list, and of those whose names appear for the first time on the list of qualified voters."
